SANT BABA RANJEET SINGH PUBLIC SR. SEC. SCHOOL, MULLOWAL (SANGRUR) is a co-educational secondary day school situated in Village Mullowal (Sangrur). The whole school campus is spread across lush green area of approximately 10 bighas. The sylvan setting is strikingly beautiful and ideal for an institution of this type. The school is being run on public school lines. It is managed by LOTUS EDUCATIONAL SOCIETY (REGD.), MULLOWAL (SGR.). The aim of our school is turning out physically strong students known for their wisdom who are intelligent enough to take correct decisions and are fully aware right and wrong.

Aims and Objectives :

SANT BABA RANJEET SINGH PUBLIC SR. SEC. SCHOOL, MULLOWAL (SANGRUR) is open to all without distinction of race, creed, caste or social status, with a view to

- a) provide school education of high academic-standard to children and to promote their all round development in the background of Indian culture and religious heritage, imbibing respect for moral and ethical values in the light of the universal teachings of spiritual saints of India.
- b) foster essential characteristics of Public School Education, like discipline , esprit de corps, building up of character, team work, physical development, sense of chivalry, fair play, honesty, integrity in all walks of life and inculcating spirit of sacrifice and service.
- c) promote spirit of Indian Nationalism and National solidarity by inculcating respect for all religions, tolerance, mutual co-operation in building up the nation and emotional integration.
- d) build up character by personal guidance, individual attention and provide facilities to students to grow up honest, useful and patriotic citizens with a firm and religious base.

Infrastructure & Games and Sports :

The School is spread over 3 acres of land. The surroundings are picturesque as the premises are strategically placed. The school has two wings i.e. Junior and Senior:

1. Well stocked Library with rich collection of books consisting of Encyclopedia, Handbooks, Dictionaries, Atlases & Internet facility for reference.
2. Internet facility is available in both the computer labs that are equipped with 20 P-Dual Core Network Computers.
3. Provision for Western, Indian, Classical, Vocal Music & Dance.
4. A fully air conditioned block for Junior students.
5. School has grounds for Cricket, Badminton, Basket Ball, Roller Skating and and Athletics. Teams regularly perform well at District/State Level/ CBSE fixtures and SGFI games.

Co-Curricular Activities :

In order to realise the highest ideal of education and inculcate a healthy competition among the students, the school has been divided into:

The Student Council consists of the Head Boy, the Head Girl, the Sports Captain, the House Captain, the House vice Captain, Discipline-In-charge, Programme-In-charge and others. It functions under the guidance of the Head Co-ordinator and four House Masters. The council meets, once a month to organize, analyse and put into action various school activities. It also helps in maintaining discipline.

School Uniform

1. Students are expected to attend the school in proper school uniform. .
2. Non-kesadhari boys should keep their hair short. Patka is compulsory for the Kesa-dhari boys up to 5th class.
3. Turban is compulsory for the Kesa-Dhari boys of classes 6th to 12th.
4. For girls, the correct length of skirt is mandatory. Buttoning of cuffs is must for both boys and girls.
5. Student must be regular and punctual to the school. They must dress-up in proper neat uniform to the school otherwise disciplinary action will be taken against the offender.
6. Mehndi on hands, nail varnish and streaking of hair is not permitted.

School Rules

1. Converse only in English in the Class and in the School Campus.
2. Attend the classes on time and be seated quietly.
3. Respect the rights of other students and do not disturb or interrupt the class.
4. Respect the personal space of other students and follow a 'no touch' policy.
5. Respect and co-operate with teachers and other students.
6. Be attentive, follow the instructions of the teachers and work quietly during class hours.
7. Raise your hand and wait for your turn to speak in the class.
8. Always obtain teacher's permission before asking any questions, talking to other students or moving within the class room.
9. Take the out pass from the teacher before leaving the class for any reason whatsoever.
10. The class leader will take charge of the class during change of teachers between two periods and the students of that class will maintain absolute discipline during that time.
11. In the absence of the teacher, the Class leader will be in charge of the class and all the students should obey his/her instructions.
12. Students are not allowed to enter a classroom that does not belong to them.
13. Changing of classrooms between periods should be done in silence and in an orderly manner.

Admission Procedures

Admissions is normally done only in Nursery every year. In other classes, admission is strictly based on availability of seats and admission test.

Age Eligibility : As on 1st april in the year of admission

- a) 3 years old in Nursery class
- b) 4 years old in LKG class
- c) 5 years old in UKG class
- d) 6 years old in First class

On basis of previous class results and R.T.E. age category

Admission Test

- On the spot admission test will take in Feb., March for all classes. The test will be held in English and Mathematics and in any other subject which may be considered necessary.
- The selection of the candidates will depend upon the child's performance in the tests and availability of seats in the concerned class.
- The result of the test & the last date for the submission of fee will be specified at the time of the test. • Bus route & stops are fixed after careful study and no request for creation of new stop or change of bus stop/route during the session (April-March) will be entertained . Any request for the above should reach the school before the beginning of new session by March 15 and the routes and stoppages would be finalized for the year by 31 March.
- Students will be held responsible for any damage caused by negligence or vandalism in the bus. Unruly behaviour like shrieking and shouting is strictly prohibited.
- Payment of the fees can be made through the Bank cheque and cash ONLY as per Pay-in-slip details. The Fee is to be deposited by 30 of the month as per the scheduled date of payment . Thereafter, fine of Rs. 100/- will be charged per month. If the fees along with the late fees is not paid for over 6 months in a year, then his/her name may be struck off from the school rolls automatically. If not authorized, re-admission charges will be payable if the school permits him/her to rejoin the school.
- Fee once paid is not refundable.

Withdrawal

- Parents should give at least one month notice in writing or pay a month's fee in advance before withdrawal of their ward. If however the student is asked by the school to leave, the fee will not be charged from the date of order.
- The transfer certificate will not be issued until all dues are settled and NOC is submi
